**2. Admission for the year 2017-18:** The admission procedure for classes I and XI was successfully completed, as per the KVS guidelines, without any discrepancy, by the admission committee headed by **Mr.Vijay Kumar.V**, PGT (Maths), KV Kanjikode. ### **3. Achievements:**

#### **a. Academics:**

##### **Class XII**

Kendriya Vidyalaya Kanjikode secured 99.15% in AISSCE 2017 with a Performance Index of 81.38. 118 students appeared in the examination and 117 passed. Science Stream secured 100% and the Commerce Stream 97.06%. 17 students secured A1 in all subjects.

##### **TOPPERS:**

The toppers in the Science stream are **SHARAN KISHORE** first in the Vidyalaya with 97%, **NIRUPAM.V** second with 96.8% followed by **SREESHANKAR.M** with 96%.

The toppers in the Commerce stream are **ANAGHA MANOHAR I** First in the vidyalaya (95.60%), **ANAGHA VINOD** Second (95.40%) \_\_\_\_\_ **MEENAKSHI G NAIR** **THIRD 464 (92.80%)**

**Anagha Sivadas and Sharan Kishore** received appreciation certificates and trophy for getting 100% in Mathematics and **Alen Joe Antony** received appreciation certificates and trophy for getting 100% in from the Deputy commissioner, RO, Ernakulam for getting 100% in Computer Science.

##### **Class X**

The Vidyalaya achieved 100% pass result with a Performance Index of 85.60 in the AISSE 2016- (class X examination and a total number of 40 students secured A1 in all subjects. They became eligible for a merit certificate and cash award of Rs. 5000/- each from KVS.

#### **b. Sports:**

i) CLUSTER LEVEL CHESS TOURNAMENT was hosted by the Vidyalaya for boys and girls under 14, Under 17 and Under 19 on 10<sup>th</sup>,

11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of July this year. Students from 5 schools of the region – KV Kanjikode, KV Thrissur, KV No1 Palakkad, KV No 1 and No 2 Calicut participated in the tournament.

- ii) REGIONAL LEVEL Meet for Kabaddi was hosted by the Vidyalaya for boys and girls Under 14 and Under 19 on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of July 2017. Four Clusters of the region – Palakkad, Trivandrum, Ernakulam and Kannur participated in the same
- iii) Palakkad Cluster won First in the U-14 KVS Regional Kabaddi Tournament (Boys) held at KV Kanjikode. Ernakulam Cluster secured second position. Third position was secured by Kannur Cluster.
- iv) Trivandrum Cluster won First in the U-19. Palakkad Cluster secured second position and third position was bagged by Kannur Cluster.

**c. Visits**

- i. Sri. C.Karunakaran, Hon. Asst. Commissioner visited the Vidyalaya in the month of July to meet the students and teachers and the students of the Vidyalaya who are appearing for the Board Examinations in March 2018, when he gave them encouragement and tips to prepare and do well in the Examination. He also directed the teachers on the methods to be adopted for ensuring results on par with the best in the nation.

**d. SCOUTS AND GUIDES**

1. The **Enrolment** work for the year 2017-18 was completed in the first week of April,2017.
2. **Flag break** ceremonies, **Regular classes** and training to Scouts & Guides were imparted on all Wednesdays during the assembly time, from 8.30 to 9.15 , for covering the syllabus as per APRO Part- II & III.
3. **Guard of Honour** was organized on the Annual Day to receive the Chief Guest and other guests on 01-04-17.
4. **Guard of Honour** was organized on the ‘Anyonyam’ CD release day to receive the Chief Guest : Mrs. Marykutty IAS, Hon. Dist Collector.
5. **35 saplings** were planted to observe the Environment day by Scouts & Guides in the Vidyalaya Campus. The programme was inaugurated by the Principal, Smt. K Rajeswari and Vice Principal, Sri. M Subramanian, Mrs. Ammu Chungath, Mrs. S Santha, Mrs. NC Durgalakshmi and others were the teachers In-charge. 40 Scouts & Guides participated.
6. Our Vidyalaya was the venue for the **Cluster Level Tiritiya Sopan cum patrol Leaders training Camp** for Scouts of District III & IV:

Our Principal and former Dist Commissioner- **Smt. K Rajeswari** was the Camp Director.

The Camp was conducted from 13 -07- to 15 -07-2017. 164 Scouts from 17 schools escorted by 16 teachers and 4 officials attended the camp. Various tests were conducted on Pravesh, Pratham, Dwitiya & Tiritiya level syllabus, both written and oral. Adequate training in the skills and knowledge up to Tiritiya Sopan was given by the testing officials.

e. **Extra Curricular Activities**

- i. Anyonyam phase II was released by the honourable Collector of Palakkad in a function at the Vidyalaya when students of class VII and VIII who had studied a number of National Anthems were interviewed by the media and Mrs Leena Mukundan spoke about her novel venture.
- ii. Miss. Malavika Rajesh, young author Interacted with the Readers' Club members on 26 July 2017 at the Multipurpose Hall. Malavika Rajesh is the author of "Watch Out", a collection of short novel and two short stories. In her address, Malavika shared her experience as a student and a writer and informed the audience how she could cope with the stress when she lost the sweetness of her voice, as she took up writing poems and stories. She told the students not to be disheartened "when a door closes, instead look for another and be confident to follow the dreams".
- iii. The Book Donation Drive which started on 15 June 2017 got a tremendous response from everyone. It is being organised in connection with the Reading Week celebrations. The programme to strengthen the library collection was taken by everyone with enthusiasm and the response was above expectations.
- iv. **AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CYBER SECURITY AND ETHICAL HACKING (ALUMNI)**  
Mr. Sidharth M, introduced the students to the concept of cyber security and ethical hacking and detailed the career prospects in the field. He discussed various topics like viruses, online privacy, phishing, hacking, Internet of Things and many other internet safety and/or security issues with the students. He also introduced the students to Junior InCTF a competition on Ethical Hacking organised by Amritha University for School Students.
